

COMET SEKI-LINES, 1962c

Date: April 17/18, 1962.

Comet Seki-Lines was observed in a 4" reflector at 65x and 130x and in 4x40mm binoculars, from 01h 50m to 02h 15m U.T. Estimated magnitude was between 3.8 and 4.2. The diameter of the head was measured as 3'.9 by noting the time to pass out of view as 17 seconds. Extra care was made to be sure this timing was true, but this measured value still seems to small. The length of the tail was about 0:7
