Dear Miss Northcott,


Thank-you for your letter of May 22. I regret the delay in answering, but I just received your letter which was forwarded to me in Ottawa where I expect to be for a short time.

Since Mr. Dickinson has taken charge of the Variable Star Section, I now think that the light curve of Nova Herculis should not be published with my report. I expect that he will wish to include it in one of his reports.

The main purpose of my paper is to introduce the Comet and Nova Section to all R.A.S.C. members, so the drawing of comet Seki-Lines is not important to the report. I did not bring the comet drawings to Ottawa with me, so I cannot send you another one. I think that the report would be satisfactory without a drawing.

I doubt if it is necessary to change the report (at this late date) to explain the cooperation between Mr. Dickinson and myself. I can do this in my next "Bulletin" which, I expect, will be issued soon after publication of my report.
